

After surgery, mastectomy patients need drainage tubes attached to collection bulbs to remove excess fluids from their bodies. These drainage tubes and bulbs can cause a strain on the incision site. In order to support the tubes and collection bulbs, many mastectomy patients use a support bag to put these items in. Additionally, compression pillows help soothe the pain at the incision site to hasten recovery. These items are not frequently manufactured and tend to be hard to find.
